Sheffield City Centre:

Winter Garden - the largest urban glasshouse in Europe with 2,500 varieties of plants.

Peace Garden - outdoor urban Garden Square next to the Winter Garden and home to the Sheffielder's War Memorial, the Goodwin Fountain and the Holberry Cascades - the Fountain & Cascades represent the rivers and industrial heritage of Sheffield.

Sheffield Theatreland, the largest outside of London - the Crucible & Studio Theatre, The Lyceum & Library Theatre. A mix of modern and classic theatre venues hosting sporting events as well as modern and classic theatre productions and music events.

The Cutlery Works - the largest independent Food Hall in Northern England created from an historic Cutlery Manufacturing site.

The Artisan Tour

A unique food and drink experience, this walking tour of Kelham Island is a fun, social and informative way to discover the area, meet the people behind the Artisan businesses and taste fantastic produce made in Sheffield. Gain insight into the intricate detail of production and sample the finest quality coffee, cheese, chocolate, baked goods and local produced gin and beer. The tours also provide a fascinating insight into the history of the island which dates back to the 12th century. All food and drink provided is included in the price of the ticket.

Tour Highlights (this can vary but provides an example):

- Taste and learn about coffee, it's flavours and the roasting process.
- Visit the first and only urban cheesemaker in Sheffield. Enjoy a tour of the cheese make-room and hear out about the cheese making process. Finish with samples of their flagship cheese 'Little Mester'
- Visit Bullion Chocolate - one of the only bean-to-bar chocolate makers in the North. Experience a chocolate factory in action, and sample some of the best chocolate in the UK! (Stocked at Harvey Nichols and Fenwicks)
- Visit the area's bakery, see behind the scenes and sample some of the baked goods in town.
- Enjoy a tasting session of a wine/local beer or local gin
